

This open zoological garden, designed under the theme of closer inter-relationship with animals, holds about 500 animals of 50 species including capybaras, kangaroos, Bolivian squirrel monkey, prairiedogs, flamingos and waterfowl. Visitors are welcome to touch and feed most animals, feeling their warmth and vitality firsthand

You can hold guinea pigs in the Animal Petting Farm, which is open from 10:20 to 15:00 (free). 
