Q3 Dog Run



Your dogs can roam freely here off the leash (¥60 per dog). All dogs must have registration and rabies vaccination, so all visitors and dogs can play safely.

R4 Daytime BBQ Campsite



A grassy seaside spot to enjoy a barbecue while looking out over Hakata Bay and the city of Fukuoka. Day camping sites are provided with multi-purpose toilets and outdoor cooking areas. Rental barbecue equipment is also available. We recommend making reservations for day camping.

S2 The Scenery of Genkai Sea



You can enjoy a beautiful panoramic view of "Uminonakamichi" (literally, "the road through the sea," a spit of land stretching between the Genkai Sea and Hakata Bay) from the Uminaka Future Bridge. The pleasant sea breeze makes cycling and walking here delightful.

Bicycle Rental and Cycling



Rental bicycles are available for adults and children, including bicycles with training wheels or child seats, power-assisted bicycles and tandem bicycles. Child safety helmets are also available. Bicycles are a handy way to get around in the vast area of the park. You may also bring your own bicycles into the park.

S3 Eco-Friendly Forest

We provide visitors with a chance to help cultivate a forest from the very beginning. You are welcome to plant a seedling yourself, interacting with other people and experiencing first-hand the flow of magnificent nature. Nature-related events such as nature observation and agricultural experience are held at the waterside, and in the fields of the *satoyama**1. 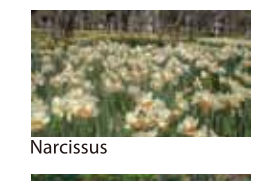

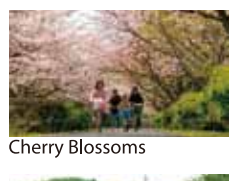

This Fukuoka city youth outdoor activity center provides a variety of outdoor recreation, such as rowing, outdoor cooking, campfires and nature observation. The facility is available for use by individuals, families and groups. A reservation is required for group use.

This aquarium is themed on the Tsushima Current that flows in the adjacent sea. It features a lot of entertaining events including dolphin and seal show and marine science workshop. There are also various hands-on programs such as the one where you can try feeding sea lions and aquarium back stage tour.

The marina offers yacht mooring, while visitors can enjoy motor boating, jet skiing and wakeboarding here. In the tennis area, fourteen all-weather courts are available, along with log cabins, and facilities for night tennis matches. Tennis competitions and tennis school are also held here, and Football courts are available.

Please note the following:

- Visitors may enter and leave the park freely within the same day. (Visitors may also change parking areas.)
- Smoking within the park is prohibited except at marked smoking areas.
- The use of fire, including bonfires and fireworks, is prohibited.
- Do not bring dangerous items into the park, such as wood or metal bats, baseballs (soft, hard or regulation-type), golf clubs, skateboards, kickboards or radio-controlled toys.
- Do not ride bicycles off the cycling course. Always use designated bicycle areas.
- All pets must be leashed or caged, and owners are responsible for cleaning up after them.
- We request that visitors take their waste home with them.
- Wheelchairs, electric carts and baby strollers are available free of charge at all gates. please ask the staff at each gate. (Please note that the number of wheelchairs is limited.)
- No admission or parking fees are charged those carrying identification passbooks for those with physical or mental disabilities, or special child identification. One attendant accompanying each such individual may also enter free of charge. Note that fares for passbook holders and one attendant each are halved for the park train and bicycle rentals, etc. Inquire for details.
- Free parking for the disabled is available at the Westside Cycling Center Gate.

Fukuoka City "Baby Station"

Some of the nursing rooms in the park are registered as Fukuoka City "Baby Stations."

- Baby seats, baby chairs and nursing rooms are located near main facilities.
- Feel free to ask for hot water for formula at management buildings and shops.
- Free baby strollers are available at all gates.

Yellow triangular flags

These yellow flags are placed at elevations at least 7 or 10 meters above sea level, depending on local terrain at the Animal Forest Observation Deck (E3), Wonder World "Children's Fortress" (H5) and West Gate open space area (G7). They will be erected at other locations in the future. They mark emergency sites to be used in the case of tsunami, and also serve as landmarks.

Walking time between main facilities

Yellow triangular flags
 These yellow flags are placed at elevations at least 7 or 10 meters above sea level, depending on local terrain at the Animal Forest Observation Deck (E3), Wonder World "Children's Fortress" (H5) and West Gate open space area (G7). They will be erected at other locations in the future.

C4 Forest House

The Forest House offers free daily craft workshops using branches, nuts, and other items found in the park. It is also the base for environmental education events.

G5 Kids Inside Play Area

Inside the management building for Children's Playground, there is a playing area for children aged 3 and younger, equipped with a cardboard box maze, picture book corner and others. Since it is located indoors, you can use this place when raining too.

G5 Flower Museum

The Flower Museum is a rooftop art museum, allowing you to enjoy the unique flowers of each season, and the fragrances of a variety of herbs. There are many photogenic spots here, and valuable tips for gardening.

H1 Seaside Hill Shioya

Seaside Hill Shioya is a recommended scenic spot from which you can look out over the vast range of sky and the Genkai Sea. A variety of flossam collected along the Uminonakamichi coast is on display at the exhibition site. HOTEL THE LUGANS also has a party room here (reservations required).

D5 Flower Hill

The largest flower garden in the park, Flower Hill is located on a low hill next to the Large Open Field. Enjoy the nemophila's azure flowers in the spring, and a beautiful carpet of cosmos rustling in the breeze during the autumn flower festival. It's the perfect place to take photographs, but be sure not to miss your favorite flowers in bloom!

F4 Rose Garden

The Rose Garden is at its most beautiful from the beginning of May to mid-June, and from mid-October to mid-November. There are about 1,500 rose bushes on display here. The garden is full of the fragrance and brilliant colors of roses blooming in full glory throughout the flowering period.

E3 Animal Forest

This open zoological garden, designed under the theme of closer inter-relationship with animals, holds about 500 animals of 50 species including capybaras, kangaroos, Bolivian squirrel monkey, prairie dogs, flamingos and waterfowl. Visitors are welcome to touch and feed most animals, feeling their warmth and vitality firsthand.

You can hold guinea pigs in the Animal Petting Farm, which is open from 10:20 to 15:00 (free). Petting Animal Garden where you can touch goats, miniature pigs, land tortoises and other animals, is also open from 10:00 to 16:00 (free). The Garden is only open on weekends and public holidays during major event periods in autumn and spring (10:00 to 15:00). Eco-Navi provides a detailed guide to the animals free every day. You can buy animal souvenirs and ice-cream cones at the Animal Museum Shop in the Animal Forest Rest House, and try on animal costumes too!

H5 Wonder World

A treasure-house of fun for children, with playground equipment such as the free Whale Cloud "Fluff-Poline" (a dome-shaped trampoline, for ages 12 and under only), Splash Fountain, the new "Snag" Waterside Playpark, and the Jabujabu Pond where children are free to splash around. Parents can comfortably keep a close watch on their children from nearby chairs and under shady trees. Pay amusements are also located here, including Go-Karts. The Wonder Shuttle offers a restaurant and a free place to rest.

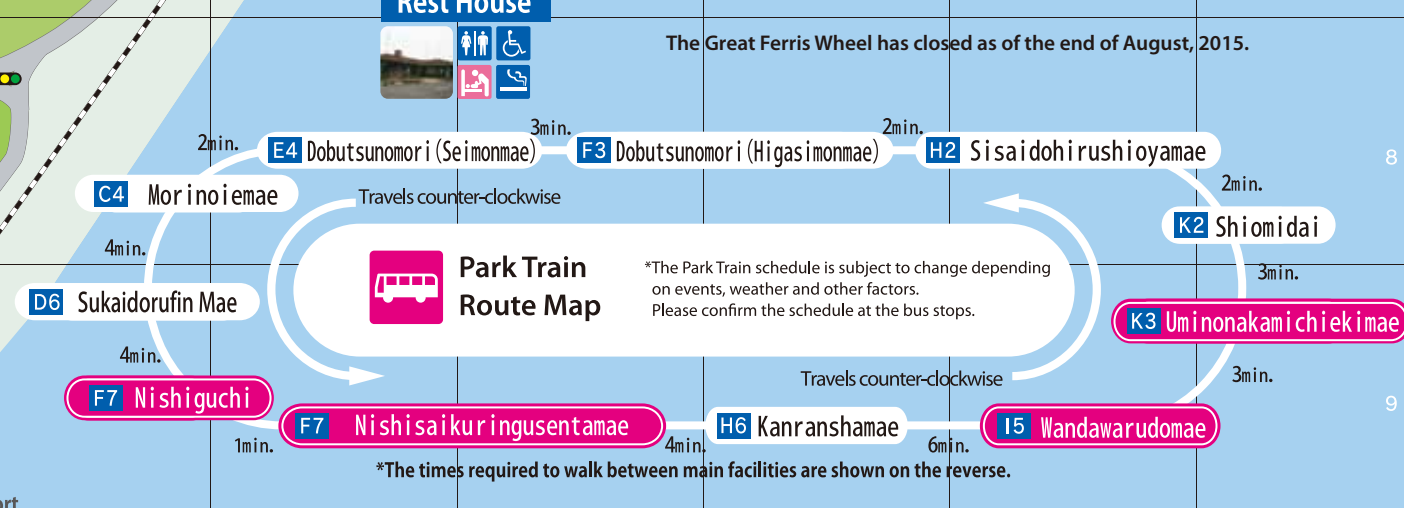

G3 Sunshine Pool

(summer only)

The park has a variety of unique swimming pools such as the Current Pool, Forest Lake Pool, Dinosaur Fountain Pool, Toddler's Wading Pool, and Water Jungle Pool, and a number of food stalls. Visitors are welcome to swim all day! One of the most popular slides is the Dragon Sliders, which comes in three types: the Fire Dragon, Tube Dragon and Little Dragon. The Fire Dragon is for experts, while people slide down the Tube Dragon with an inflated plastic tube. The Little Dragon is for children and beginners.
